

# THE PASSOVER SEDER

## Streaming Access Instructions

Your personal license enables access on a maximum of **3** devices.

**CAUTION:** Multiple browsers on the same device count as separate devices.


1. In a web browser, go to [view.protectedpdf.com/portal/milesbcohen](http://view.protectedpdf.com/portal/milesbcohen).
2. Enter your username from your “Getting Started with the Rinnah Utfillah Passover Seder” email message.

If you have not yet created a personal password at this site:	If you already created a personal password at this site:
Enter the temporary password <b>5785</b> . Follow the screen prompts to create a personal password. Then, click/tap <b>Continue</b> .	Enter your personal password.

Your licensed product(s) appear(s) as a *tile* display.

**NOTE:** Some devices also offer a *folder* display.

To change to folder display:

- a. In the upper left, click/tap the **View Options** icon .
- b. Select **Lists**. Your licensed product(s) appear as a *folder* display.

3. Click/tap **The Passover Seder** tile/folder to display the audio files and introduction.
4. To open a file, click/tap the file name.  
The file opens in a new browser tab.
5. To access additional files, return to the browser tab where you selected the file.


### Tips

- Click/tap to start, stop, or replay as often as desired.
- You may download and print the introduction.

### Future Access

- For easy access, bookmark [view.protectedpdf.com/portal/milesbcohen](http://view.protectedpdf.com/portal/milesbcohen).
  - For 1-click/tap access, create a shortcut to this URL on your desktop or home screen.
- You are not required to log in again until you clear your browser’s cookies.

### Offline Listening

1. While connected to the internet, open a desired audio file.
2. On the right, click/tap the **Save to browser** icon .
3. Bookmark the current webpage.
4. For 1-click/tap access, create a shortcut to this URL on your desktop or home screen.

### NOTES

1. When your device is not connected to the internet, your browser accesses the copy in the cache.
- Clearing your browser cache also clears the stored audio files.
  - To resave an audio file, follow the instructions above for offline viewing.
